ABOUT LORETO COLLEGE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY

Loreto College was founded in 1912 by the Sisters of the Institute of the Blessed Virgin Mary (IBVM), commonly known as Loreto, a catholic religious order established by Mary Ward in 1609. The College has a rich history marked by its pioneering role in women's education in India. In 1912-1913, it became one of the first women's colleges to gain affiliation to the University of Calcutta. The College holds the honour of being the first in West Bengal to be assessed by the NAAC in 2000, and successfully undergoing four cycles of accreditation. The College offers Four Year degrees in B.A. and B.Sc. and a Three Year Multi-Disciplinary Course offering a wide range of Major, Minor and Interdisciplinary subjects. Post graduate courses are currently offered in English and Psychology with several others due to be introduced.

Over the last 60 years, the Department of Geography has nurtured young geographers, directing students to higher academics and professional courses. The curriculum involves writing research papers, conducting seminars, tutorials, field excursions, practicals, and map-making methods. Courses offered by the Department include the Four-Year B.A./B.Sc. (Honours with or without Research) Degree and the Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Course. Courses on Geographical Information System (QGIS), Python and Artificial Intelligence are offered to enhance employability skills. The Department regularly organizes programmes on career counselling, skill development, research methodology, disaster management and contemporary issues like climate change and sustainability. Our students annually secure admission in IIM, BITS, TISS, JNU, IIT, IIPS, IISWBM, UCLA, Syracuse University, London School of Economics, etc. Our alumni are faculty members in reputed institutes and organizations across the world.
